

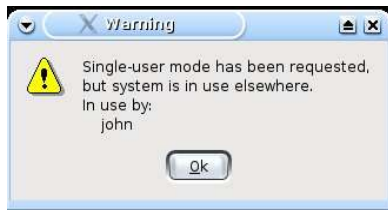

Inbuilt protection with PayThyme

. . . this warning message is displayed automatically when a user attempts to initiate a process – such as a period end update or a payroll calculation – which can be affected by changes being made to the system by another user.

Access will be denied until the process can no longer be affected by any such changes.

Support for PayThyme is based solely on employee numbers

Ongoing support for PayThyme payroll software is based solely on employee numbers, regardless of the number of payroll users or the number of payrolls that you are running.

This means that a single employer running one payroll for 1000 employees pays exactly the same as a single employer using his PayThyme software to run ten payrolls each for 100 employees or a hundred payrolls each for 10 employees.

PayThyme Support is a one-off annual cost

Regardless of how many employees you add during the year, the support subscription that you paid at the beginning of the year covers your PayThyme payroll software for the whole year.

The only time additional costs will apply is if you decide that you want something not covered by the standard support charges shown on the PayThyme website.

Such things might include the integration of PayThyme with other software, customisation of PayThyme to include non-standard features specific to your payroll and other such activities.

Inbuilt freedom courtesy of PayThyme

We provide you with the full source code for PayThyme and the tools to modify it, under our open licencing model.

This means that in the event that you decide to dispense with annual support by Clockwork, you still have a payroll that can be updated in accordance with any changes to the payroll and tax rules.
